

## **RULES**

All times are approximate. Entrants should be ready 15 minutes before start of class.

No cantering or galloping on the showground, except in the rings.

All horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over in ridden classes. No stallions or entire colts please.

All dogs on short leads.

Hard hats must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must be to current safety standards: PAS015 kitemark, ASTM F1163, VG1 kitemark, AS/NZS3838 or Snell E2001, E2016

Whips exceeding 30" are not allowed.

The decision of the judge/s is final.

Age as on day of show.

The organisers will make every effort to accommodate riders if classes clash, but will not be able to hold up classes for more than 10 minutes.

Late entry for showing at judge's discretion.

Neither the committee nor the stables shall be liable for injury to the person, or the horse or property of any competitor, spectator or other person however arising. It is deemed a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the committee, judges, stewards and other officials against any legal action arising from any incident.

Please take your litter home – no clearing out of lorries on the field.

## **RING 1 Showing**

9.00 am **All entries in this ring £7.00**

No cantering except in individual shows

- Class 1 Tack and turnout
- Class 2 Lead Rein
- Class 3 First Ridden/Complete Novice  
Never to have been placed in a showing class  
(Class will be split if sufficient entries)
- Class 4 Cob (ridden)
- Class 5 Family Pony  
To be ridden by 2 family members (child and adult)  
Optional small jump for individual show
- Class 6 Pony Club Pony/Riding Club Horse  
Judged on suitability for all PC/RC type activities. Class will be split if sufficient entries. Optional small jump for individual show
- Class 7 Mountain and Moorland (ridden)  
Class will be split into small and large breeds if sufficient entries
- Class 8 Veterans (ridden)  
Ponies or horses aged 16 or over

## **Novelty fun showing (in-hand, ridden or lead-rein)**

**These classes will run in whichever ring finishes first**

Not to start before 2.00 pm. **All classes £6.00**

- Class 9 Fancy Dress – rosette to all entrants  
Riding hats and correct footwear must be worn – no trainers
- Class 10 Handsomest gelding
- Class 11 Prettiest mare
- Class 12 Loveliest mane and tail
- Class 13 Best six legs!

## **RING 2 In-hand Showing**

9.00 am **All entries in this ring £7.00**

- Class 14 Best condition
- Class 15 Youngstock aged 3 and under  
No entire colts please
- Class 16 Mountain and Moorland  
Class will be split into small and large breeds if sufficient entries
- Class 17 Veteran  
Will be split if sufficient entries into ages 17-23 and 24 plus
- Class 18 Coloured  
Piebald, skewbald, appaloosa

## **RING 3 Clear Round Jumping** **All entries in this ring £4.00**

- 9.00-11.00 Clear Round jumps 1'6"
- 11.00-1.00 Clear Round jumps 2'0"
- 1.00-3.00 Clear Round jumps 2'3"

Trophy to be awarded to the best all-rounder aged 16 and over with highest number of points excluding novelty classes and also as above but aged under 16. Points awarded as follows

- 1<sup>st</sup> place 5 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place 3 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place 1 point
